### Fabric Weaving

Join us to learn about how to make your own fabric piece using the madweave technique. Madweave is a triaxial weave using strips woven so that they fit together snugly, completely covering a plane. These panels can then be used like a cut of fabric and turned into bags, quilts, or baskets. This weave is particularly effective at highlighting dark, medium, and low volume fabrics while creating a three dimensional effect.

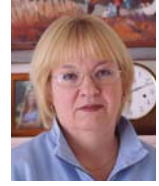
