



Class Supply List

Borders and Bindings

Supplies Needed:

Quilt Sandwich (2 Fat Quarters with batting in between)

*Prior to class – students should make a small “quilt” by stitching together a top, batting and backing. This small quilt that will be used to learn how to attach binding. Participants should feel free to use scraps, but the quilt should measure around 18” x 20”

½-yard binding fabric

Milliners needle or similar for hand-stitching

Rotary Cutter (45mm)

Rulers – 6 x 24 (approx.) and 6 ½” ruler (approx.)

Sewing Machine

Basic sewing supplies – thread, pins, scissors, etc.

Optional: personal mini iron and ironing pad, diagonal seam tape

*Threads of Tradition will have rotary cutting mats available for use, you may bring your own cutting mat if you choose.

*Each class participant is required to have their own set of supplies including the book/pattern, rulers, etc. All supplies need to be purchased prior to the date of class to ensure availability.

**It is very important that class participants have a sewing machine in proper working condition. It is equally important for class participants to have rotary cutting experience for all classes except Rotary Cutting 101.

***Purchase the listed supplies at Threads of Tradition Quilt Shop to receive 10% off your class supplies. Members receive 15% off class supplies. Cannot combine with any other discounts. One time use only per registered class. Must show proof of class registration at time of supply purchase.
