



## Mini Quilt - English Paper Piecing

## **Supplies Needed:**

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Description: The pattern *Mini Quilt* is selected from the book "Quilting On The Go...English Paper Piecing" by Sharon Burgess. This table topper measures only 14 ¼" and is made entirely of squares, rectangles and 8 pointed stars. It is constructed using only English Paper Piecing (EPP). No sewing machine required! If you have ever wanted to try your hand at English Paper Piecing, this is your chance. The individual shapes are easy-to-manage sizes, even if it is your first attempt at EPP!

## **Supply List:**

- Book: "Quilting on the go...English Paper Piecing" by Sharon Burgess (everyone must have a book)
- English Paper Piecing Papers in the following sizes: 2" 8-point star (x 32), 2" square (x 16), 2" x 4" rectangle (x 4)
- English Paper Piecing Acrylic Template in the following size: 2" 8-point star
- Fabric: Fat Quarter for background and 4 coordinating fabrics. The pattern does not list specific amounts, however fat quarters or ¼ yard cuts would give you plenty to work with! You may choose to have one fabric that can be fussy cut into a square that is 2 ½".
- 28mm rotary cutter
- Thread (such as Bottom Line) that coordinates with your fabric
- Glue Pen
- Milliner's needles (size 10 or 11)
- Small scissors for snipping threads
